## Full list of funding exclusions

We are not able to support:

- Non-arts activities
- Retrospectively (activity that has happened or will happen before we can make a decision)
- Funding for buildings, core costs and equipment
- [higher education and formal training courses](#), including course fees, living costs and materials
- Feature films and short films, with the exception of artist film and experimental animation
- Sponsorship of any kind
- Rehearsal, touring, production or staging costs for performances or exhibitions, where a specific learning or developmental focus for the artists involved is not identified (see guidance for the Jerwood New Work Fund)
- Projects involving those who have not yet left formal education
- Formal or informal education or community participation work
- Projects which support artists who are not living and working in the UK
- Grants towards the purchase of musical instruments
- Projects in the fields of religion or sport
- Animal rights or welfare appeals
- Social welfare
- General fundraising appeals
- Appeals to establish endowment funds for other charities
- Medical research
- Environmental or conservation projects
- Medical or mental health projects

If the project or activity includes one or more of these exclusions, it is highly unlikely that it will be funded by Jerwood Arts and therefore we would encourage you not to apply for support.
